### *Buying your first recorder:*

There are many good recorders available. Plastic recorders are recommended for beginners, since wooden recorders are sensitive to breath and condensation, and are much more expensive than plastics. Yamaha plastic recorders are high-quality and affordable for a beginner.

*Approximate Prices for Plastic Recorders:* Soprano \$20; Alto \$40; Tenor (with keys) \$80; Bass (bent-neck with keys) \$300; the entire family bought as a package (soprano, alto, tenor, bass) \$400

*Recommended beginner's book:* *Enjoy Your Recorder; the Trapp Family Singers' New Complete Method of Instruction for the Recorder.* There are two versions, one for C instruments (soprano/tenor) and one for F instruments (alto/bass). These can be ordered from Amazon.com or any dealer.
